



#### **OBSERVATIONS**

India intends to reduce its imports of vanilla — mainly synthetic — by intensifying the intercropping of vanilla with coconut, according to the journal *The Public Ledger*. The efforts made by the Spices Board of India throughout the past decade have made it possible to increase the area under vanilla from 300 to 1 500 ha. An increase in Indian production would make it possible to reduce imports but world demand for natural products is increasing. In 2000, world production of vanilla reached 1 100 t, of which 25 t was grown in India. Vanilla production in Madagascar has fallen from an average of 1 200 t per year to 800 t following the gales that wiped out about a third of production. Some operators report that the rest is of poor quality but that exporters are holding on to their produce to increase prices. It is undeniable that the policy is successful. Black vanilla from Madagascar is quoted at \$140 per kilo FOB in comparison with \$55 a year ago. Some traders consider that Madagascar still has 200 t in stock but that it might not be sold until April when growers need funds to finance their season. No supplies will be available from Indonesia and the Comoros until their 2001 harvest. As a result, prices should continue to rise, according to the French trader Sivanil.
