

France, particularly through its overseas territories, counts among the richest countries in the world in terms of biodiversity (endemism comparable to that of the whole of Europe, existence of hotspots and marine hotspots, of eco-regions, of centres of plant diversity, of extinct

and endangered species,...), especially in insular and marine ecosystems.

France has a presence in many geographical zones (Western and Mediterranean Europe, tropical America, and the North Atlantic, Indian Ocean, Subantarctic, Antarctic and Pacific).
