Since 2007, the wood preservation laboratory is accredited for its tests realized according to

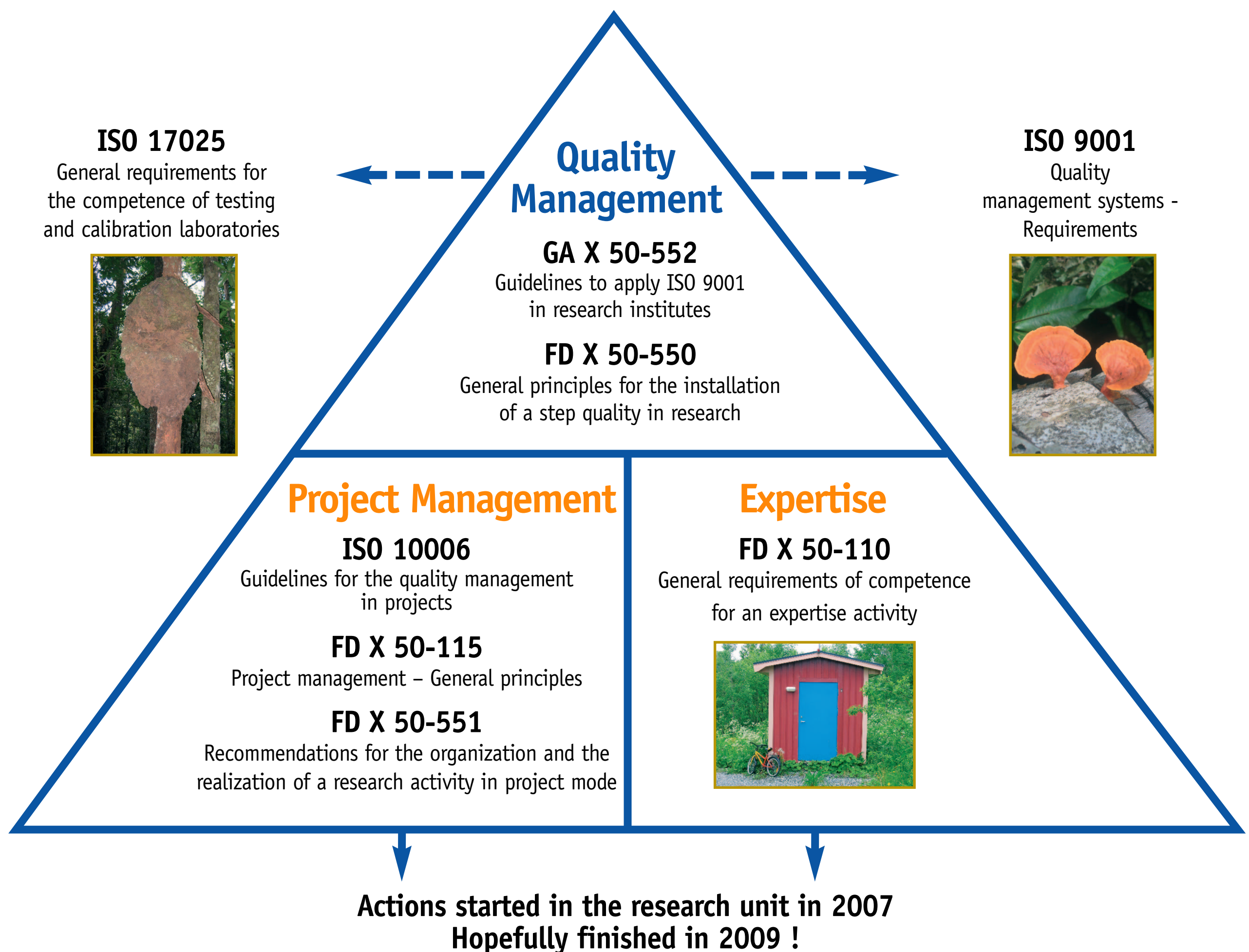
- EN73 & EN84 : Ageing tests
